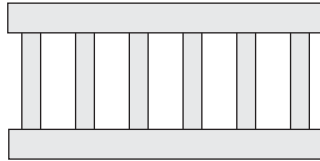

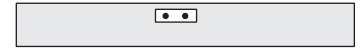

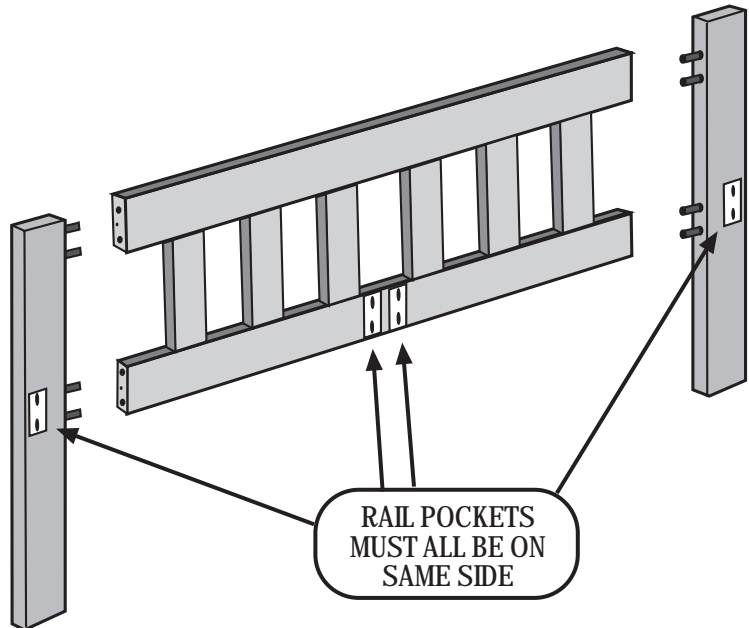
N-7 HEADBOARD CENTER SECTION (1)



N-8 HEADBOARD LEG (2)

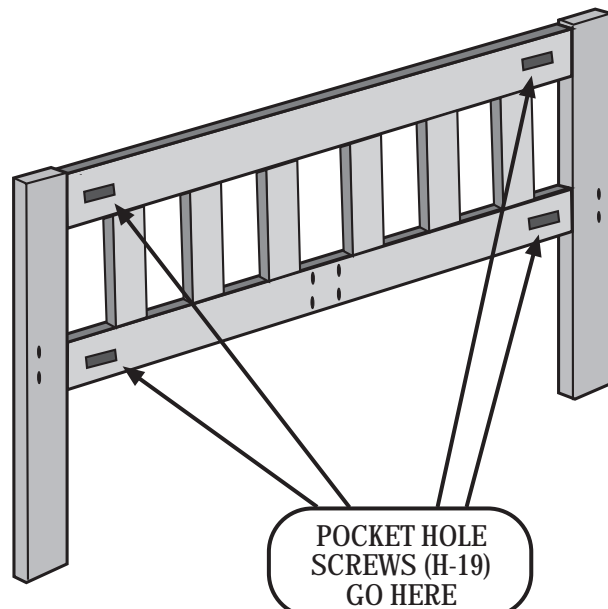

Carefully align Headboard parts as shown and press the Legs onto the center section.
Note:
You must make sure that the rail pockets are aligned as shown.

Now turn the Headboard over and secure the Headboard Legs with (4) Wood Screws (H-19).



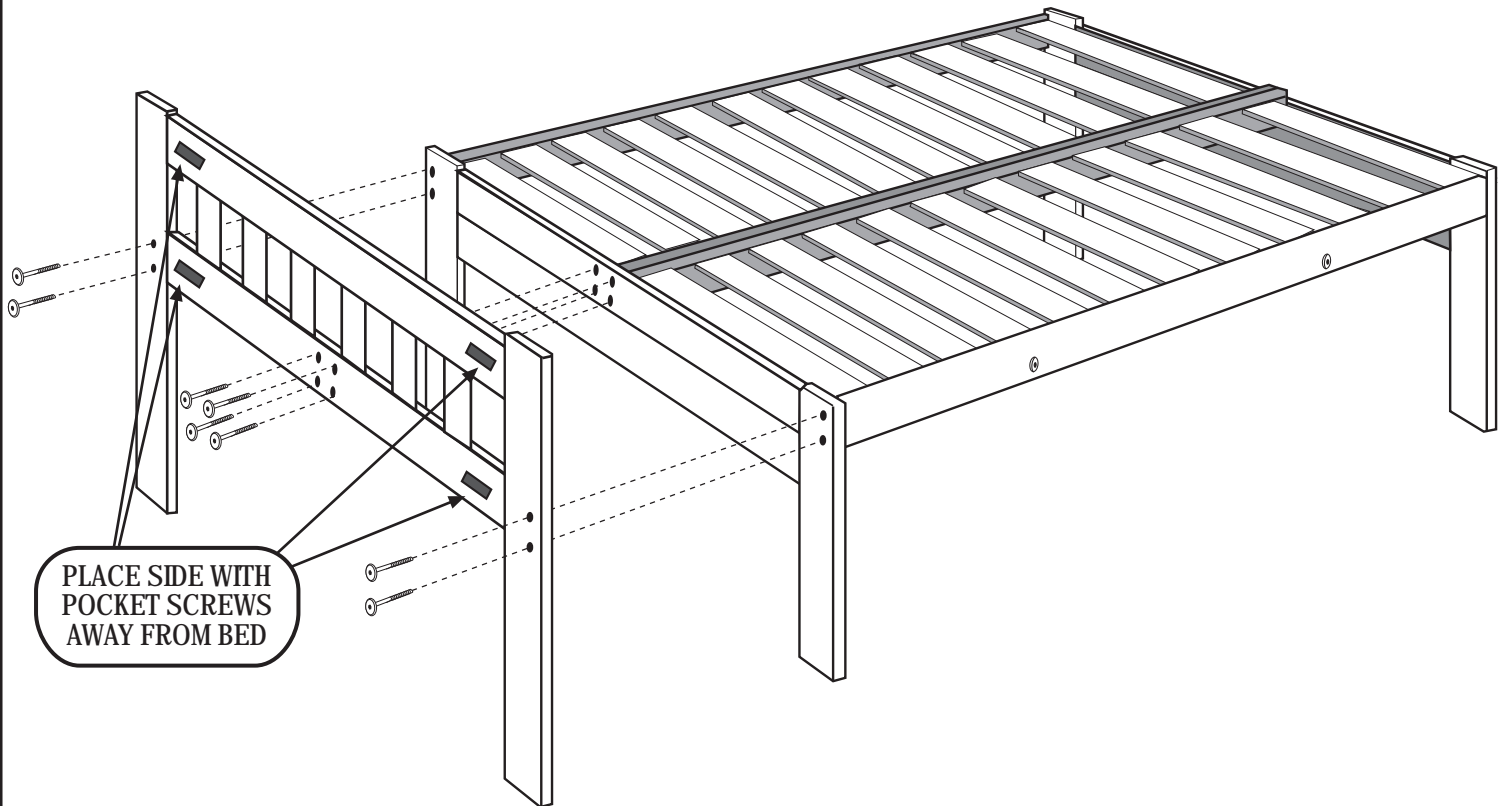

Use (8) 3-1/2" Bolts (H-2) to attach the Headboard over the Bed End. Bolts should go through the Headboard and the Bed End.

If you prefer, you can leave off the Bed End and just use the Headboard. (Use the 3" Bolts that came with the bed.)

NOTE:

In general, futon mattresses are a little shorter than traditional mattresses. So if you are using a traditional mattress, it would be better to leave the Bed End on the bed, and if you are using a futon mattress, then leave it out.
